(approximately 500 ft.) will be closed at a time, thereby keeping the construction localized and causing minimal disruptions to the residents. J.F. Temporary Street Closure

LOCATION:

Stevens Rd from Locke Ln to Chatham Ln

INFORMATION:

As part of the 2011 Public Utilities Water Main Replacement Project #2, which is located on Stevens Rd, a temporary street closure will be required to allow for the replacement of the existing water and sewer mains. The section of Stevens Road from Locke Ln to Chatham Ln and associated intersections will need to be closed August 6 to September 18, 2013. This closure is needed due the replacement of the deteriorated sewer main (beyond its useful life) on Stevens Rd. The contractor has been working closely with the Public Works Department to make sure the traffic control plans are sufficient and all surrounding residents/businesses will be least inconvenienced and have access maintained. Completed sections will be opened up as soon as they become available. All affected property owners, emergency services and news outlets will be notified in accordance with the City's standard operating procedures for

temporary street closures.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the temporary street closure as recommended.
